EXPANSION AT NORGINE MANUFACTURING SITE - UK

In order to support its expanding R&D pipeline, Norgine is investing in the construction of a dedicated technical development facility at its manufacturing site in Hengoed, South Wales.

Aided by a substantial grant from the Welsh Assembly Government, facilities will be established to enable the organisation to accelerate and better support the development of new products, through the provision of services ranging from pre-formulation and formulation development, to cGMP manufacture and packing for stability studies and clinical trials.

Construction is scheduled to start this month, with completion and occupation by the end of the year.

Commenting on this expansion Peter Martin, COO "This is another important step in emphasising Norgines' commitment to delivering new products to meet the needs of healthcare professionals and their patients".
